

Schnelleinführung zur Installation

SUSE®

Gehen Sie folgendermaßen vor, um eine neue Version von SUSE® Linux Enterprise Server 11 SP2 zu installieren. In diesem Dokument erhalten Sie einen schnellen Überblick über die Durchführung einer Standardinstallation von SUSE Linux Enterprise Server auf x86-, x86_64- und iA64-Architekturen.

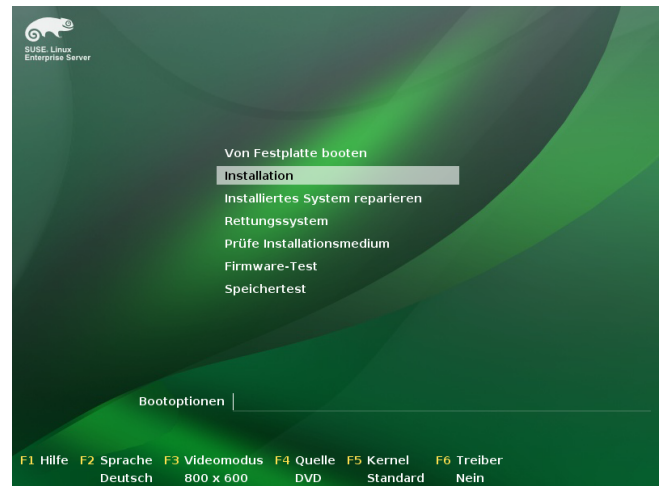
Mindestsystemvoraussetzungen

- Pentium® III-Prozessor mit 500 MHz oder höher (Pentium 4 2.4 GHz oder höher oder ein beliebiger AMD64/Intel® EM64T-Prozessor empfohlen)
- 512 MB physischer Arbeitsspeicher (1 GB empfohlen)
- 2 GB verfügbarer Festplattenspeicher (mehr ist empfehlenswert)
- 800 x 600 Bildschirmauflösung (1024 x 768 oder höher empfohlen)

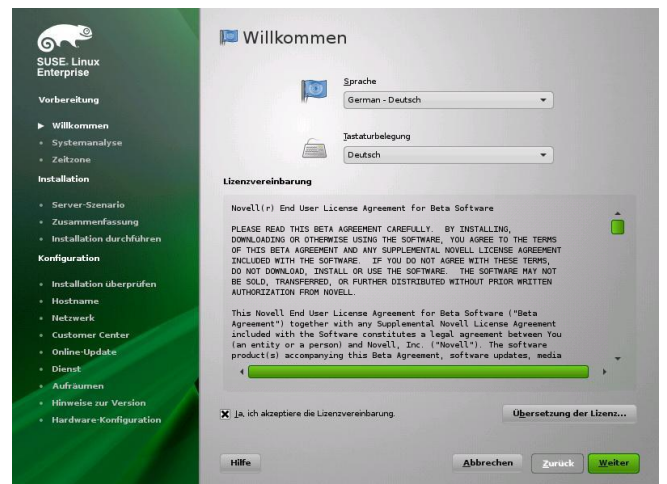
Installieren von SUSE Linux Enterprise Server

Gehen Sie entsprechend dieser Anweisungen vor, falls kein Linux-System auf Ihrem Computer installiert ist oder wenn Sie ein vorhandenes Linux-System ersetzen wollen.

1. Legen Sie die SUSE Linux Enterprise Server-DVD in das Laufwerk ein und booten Sie den Computer neu, um das Installationsprogramm zu starten.

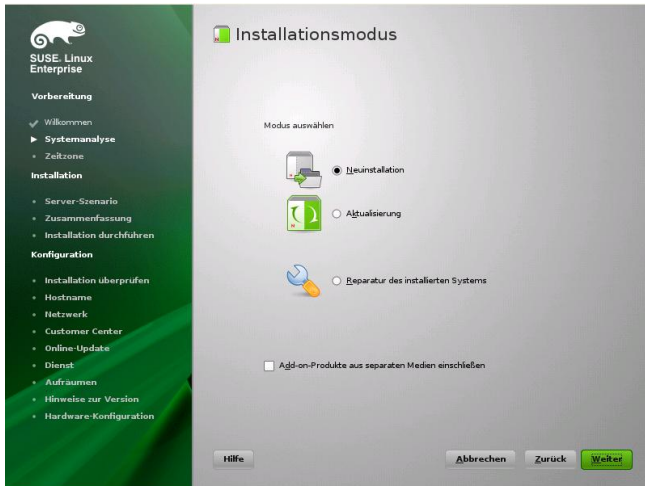


2. Wählen Sie im Startbildschirm *Installation* und drücken Sie die Eingabetaste. Dadurch wird das SUSE Linux Enterprise Server-Installationsprogramm geladen und die Installation im normalen Modus gestartet.



3. Wählen Sie die Sprache für die Installation und für das installierte System aus.

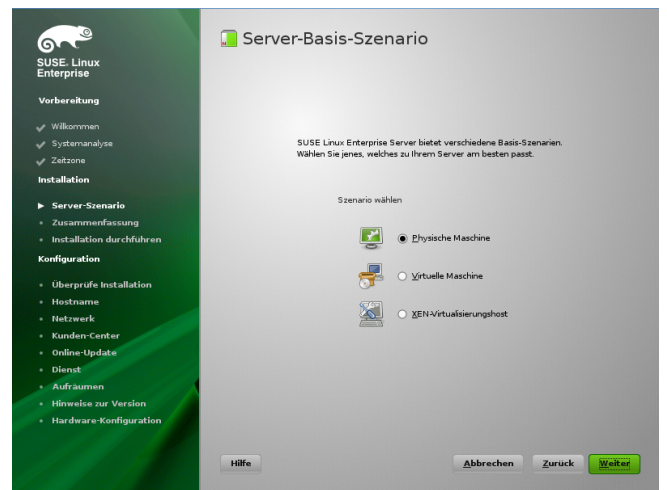
4. Lesen Sie die Lizenzvereinbarung und klicken Sie auf *Ja, ich akzeptiere diese Lizenzvereinbarung*. Fahren Sie mit *Weiter* fort.



5. Entscheiden Sie, ob eine *Neuinstallation* oder eine Aktualisierung einer früheren Version von SUSE Linux Enterprise Server durchgeführt werden soll. Fahren Sie mit *Weiter* fort.



6. Wählen Sie die in Ihrem System zu verwendende Uhr-einstellung und Zeitzone aus. Fahren Sie mit *Weiter* fort.



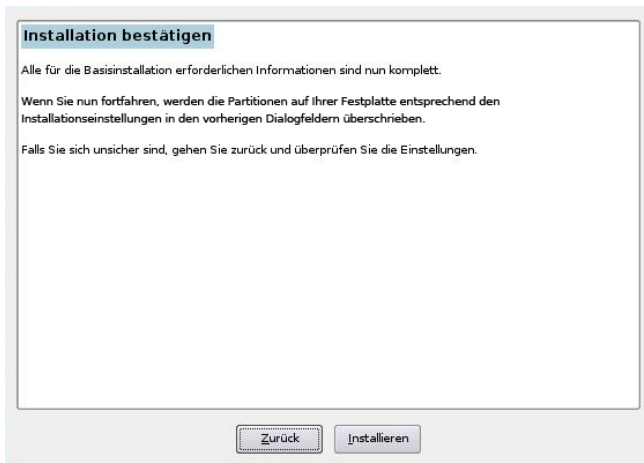
7. Entscheiden Sie, ob Sie die Installation als primäres Betriebssystem auf einem *Physischen Computer* durchführen wollen, als virtuellen Gast innerhalb eines XEN-Computers durch Auswahl von *Virtueller Computer* oder als einen Virtualisierungshost, der andere virtuelle Computer mithilfe der Option *XEN-Virtualisierungshost* ausführen kann. Fahren Sie mit *Weiter* fort.



8. Auf dem Bildschirm „Installationseinstellungen“ können Sie eine Reihe von vorgeschlagenen Installations- und Partitionierungsoptionen anzeigen und anschließend die gewünschten Optionen gegebenenfalls ändern.

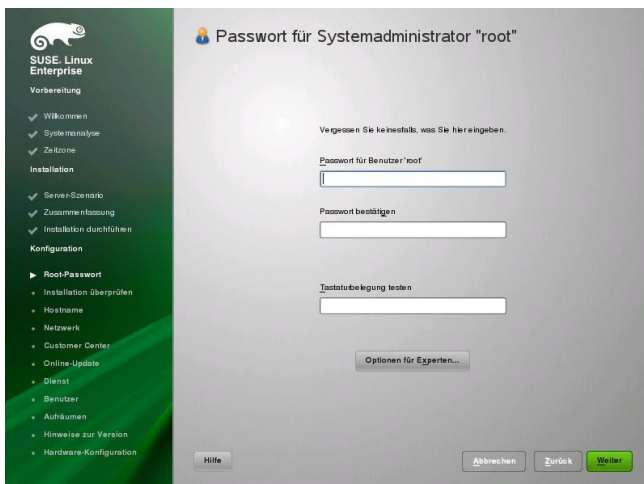
Der Karteireiter *Überblick* enthält grundlegende Optionen, bei denen manchmal manuell eingegriffen werden muss (bei den häufigsten Installationssituationen). Der Karteireiter *Experten* enthält erweiterte Konfigurationsoptionen.

9. Klicken Sie auf *Akzeptieren*, um die Lizenzvereinbarungen zu akzeptieren.



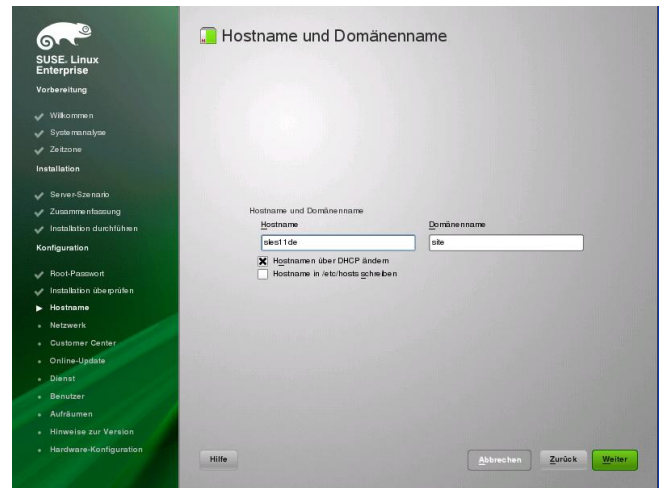
10. Starten Sie die Installation mit *Installieren*.

Nach Abschluss der grundlegenden Systemeinrichtung und der Installation aller ausgewählten Softwarepakete bootet die SUSE Linux Enterprise Server-Installation in das neue Linux-System. Nach dem Neustart erscheint der folgende Bildschirm:

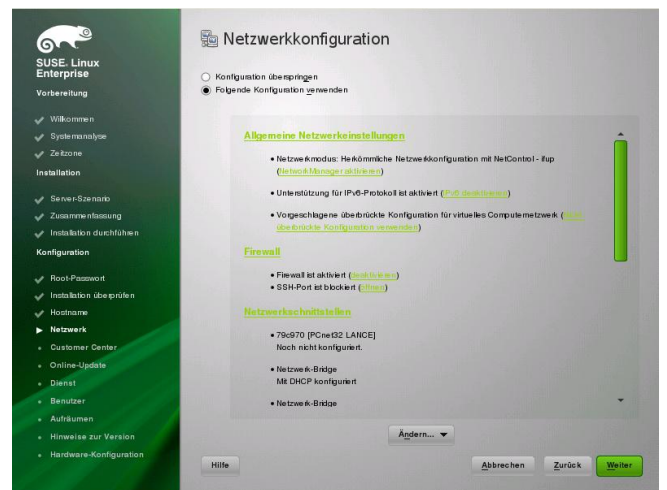


11. Geben Sie ein Passwort für das Systemadministrator-konto (als `root`-Benutzer bezeichnet) ein.

Merken Sie sich das `root`-Passwort. Nachdem Sie es hier eingegeben haben, kann es nicht mehr abgerufen werden. Es kann nur mit administrativer Hilfe zurückgesetzt werden. Fahren Sie mit *Weiter* fort.

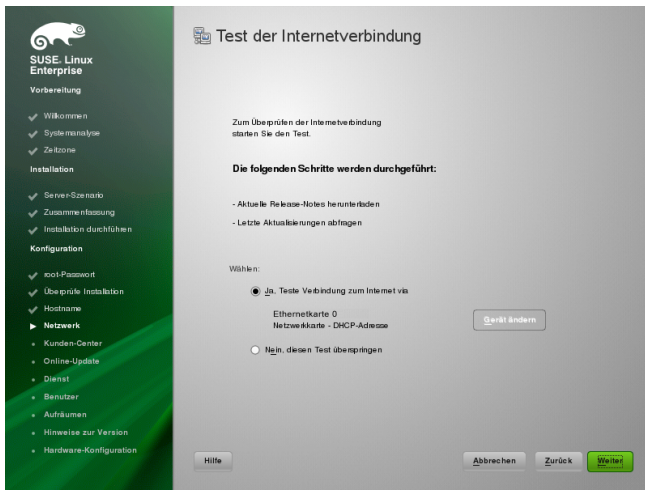


12. Geben Sie einen Namen für diesen Computer und für die dazugehörige DNS-Domäne ein. Fahren Sie mit *Weiter* fort.

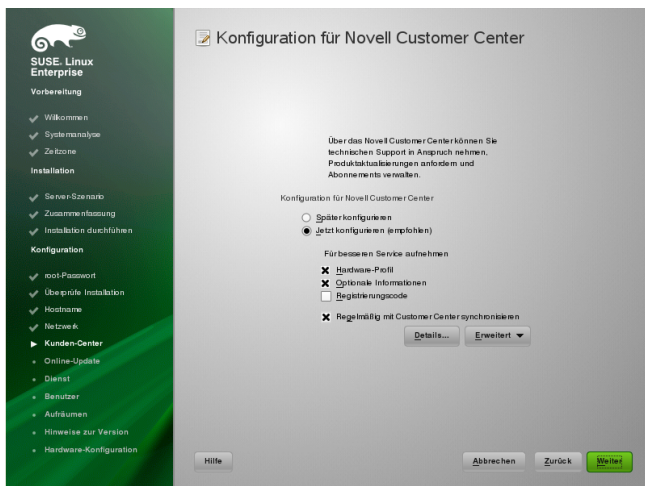


13. Im Bildschirm „Netzwerkconfiguration“ können Sie die Netzwerkverbindungen Ihres Systems anzeigen und ändern.

Wenn Sie Netzwerkgeräte verwenden (zum Beispiel Netzwerkkarten oder kabellose Karten, eine DSL-Verbindung, einen ISDN-Adapter oder ein Modem) sollten Sie diese jetzt konfigurieren. Über eine Internetverbindung kann SUSE Linux Enterprise Server alle verfügbaren Aktualisierungen abrufen und sie während der Installation anwenden. Fahren Sie mit *Weiter* fort.

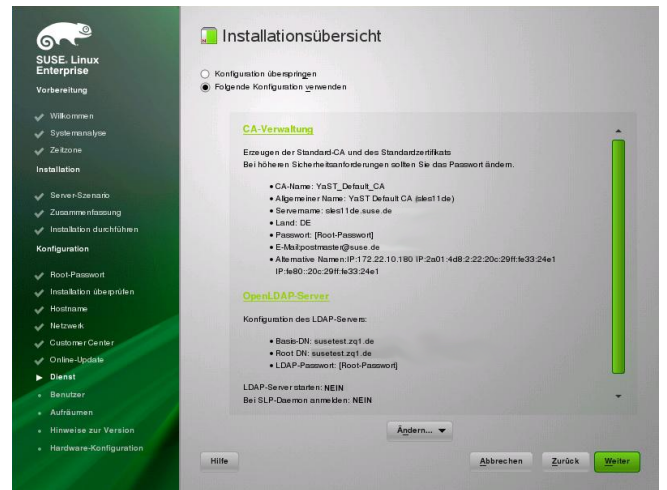


14. Testen Sie Ihre Internetverbindung mit *Ja, teste Verbindung zum Internet*. Diese Option überprüft auch die neuesten Versionshinweise für SUSE Linux Enterprise Server. Fahren Sie mit *Weiter* fort.
15. Die Testergebnisse können auf dem Bildschirm „Test der Internetverbindung“ angezeigt werden. Fahren Sie mit *Weiter* fort.

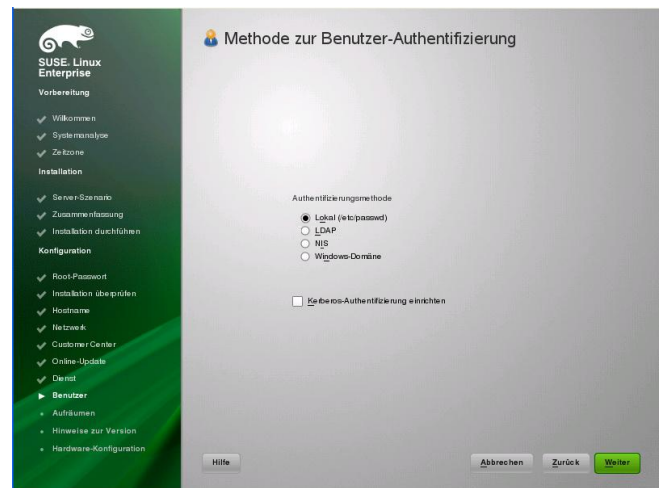


16. Aktivieren Sie im Bildschirm „Konfiguration des Novell-Kundenzentrums“ die Online-Aktualisierung Ihres Systems, indem Sie auf *Jetzt konfigurieren* > *Weiter* > *Fortfahren* klicken.

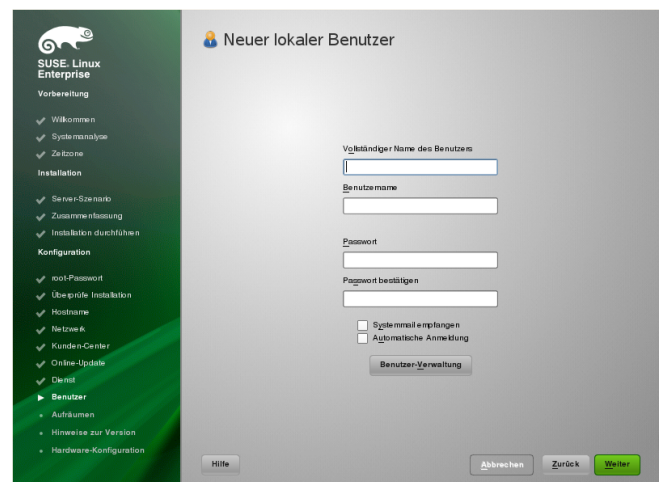
Klicken Sie auf *Später konfigurieren* > *Weiter*, um diesen Schritt zu überspringen und mit der Installation fortzufahren. Sie können die Option konfigurieren, nachdem das Produkt installiert wurde. Fahren Sie mit *Weiter* fort.



17. Standardmäßig erstellt SUSE Linux Enterprise Server ein Zertifikat für das System. Um dies zu deaktivieren, klicken Sie auf *Konfiguration überspringen* > *Weiter*. Fahren Sie mit *Weiter* fort.

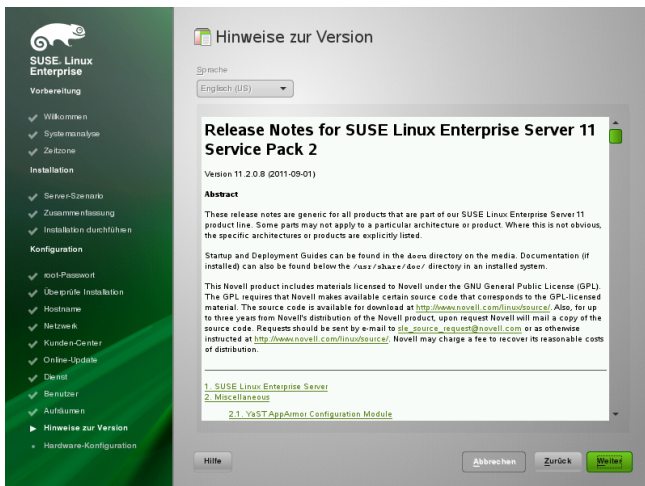


18. Wählen Sie *Lokal (/etc/passwd)* im Bildschirm „Methode zur Benutzerauthentifizierung“ aus, es sei denn Ihr Administrator hat Ihnen andere Anweisungen erteilt. Fahren Sie mit *Weiter* fort.

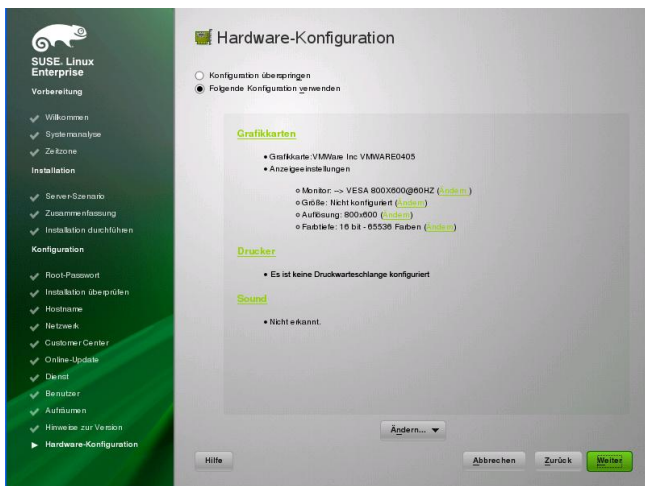


19. Geben Sie Ihren Vor- und Nachnamen in das Feld *Vollständiger Name des Benutzers* ein, Ihren Benutzernamen (Login) in das Feld *Benutzername* und ein Passwort (wie von Ihrem Systemadministrator empfohlen) in das Feld *Passwort*.

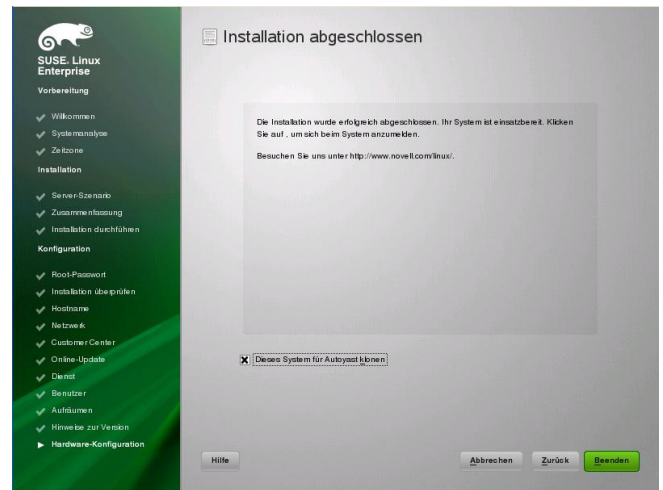
Aus Sicherheitsgründen sollte Ihr Passwort mindestens acht Zeichen lang sein und sowohl Groß- als auch Kleinbuchstaben und Zahlen enthalten. Für Passwörter sind maximal 72 Zeichen zulässig. Beachten Sie die Groß-/Kleinschreibung bei Passwörtern. Fahren Sie mit *Weiter* fort.



20. Sehen Sie sich nach Abschluss der Systemkonfiguration die Versionshinweise an. Fahren Sie mit *Weiter* fort.



21. Im Bildschirm „Hardware-Konfiguration“ können Sie Ihre Grafikkarte und andere Hardwaregeräte anzeigen oder konfigurieren. Fahren Sie mit *Weiter* fort.



22. Klicken Sie im Bildschirm „Installation abgeschlossen“ auf *Beenden*, um die Installation von SUSE Linux Enterprise Server abzuschließen und mit dem Anmeldebildschirm fortzufahren.
23. Geben Sie Ihren Benutzernamen ein und geben Sie Ihr Passwort im Feld *Passwort* ein und drücken Sie anschließend die *Eingabetaste*.

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
